- Official high school transcript. All transcripts must be submitted using the grading policy/GPA scale currently used by their school; additionally, ACT/SAT scores
- Student must reside and attend a high school in Bexar County.
- Acceptance letter from college/university (copy must be enclosed with application)
- Two Letters of Recommendation (LOR) from a high school teacher, counselor, social worker, religious official, or school principal. The letters must include your potential to be successful in college; and have two contact numbers, e-mail address, and full name.

- Personal Statement must be typed, Times New Roman style, font size 12, double spaced. The statement should address the all of the following:
  - A brief biography about yourself
  - A description of your scholastic and career ambitions
  - A description of your involvement in current extra-curricular and community service activities.
